A reminder that the next friends meeting is Thursday 2nd November 8pm at the Village Inn.

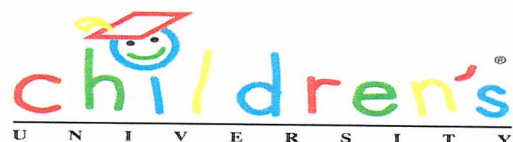

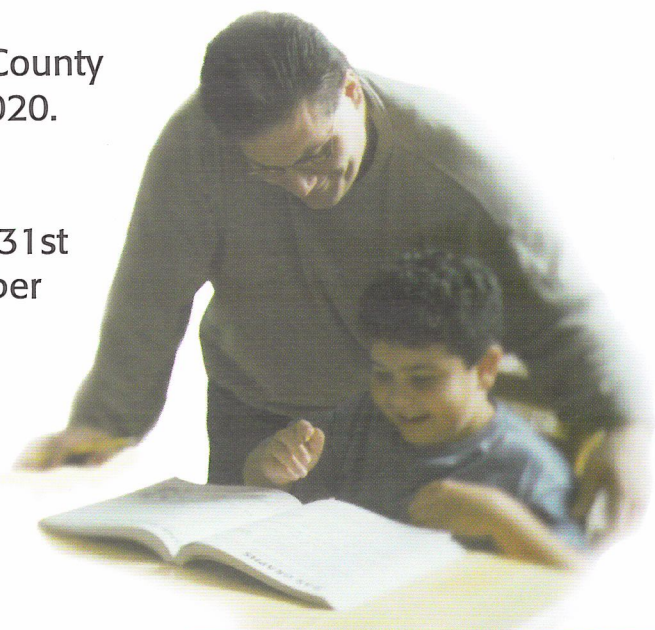
