APPLE TARTS

- Vanilla sugar (3 tb)

- Caster sugar (1 tb)
- Water

Don't forget to cut the bad bit of the apple out...

1. Roll the pastry into a tin and on the sides of it.

2. Carefully cut all six apples into thin slices, then put them in a bowl with water and caster sugar.

Hi Hi Hi I'm Mr Mcapple, don't play with knives they're very sharp!

3. Lay them on the tray and then add Vanilla sugar and lemon juice.
4. Now, cook the tart at 220°C (fan) or 200°C (gas 7) for 15-20 minutes.
5. After it is cooked, spread apricot jam on it.
6. Enjoy!
