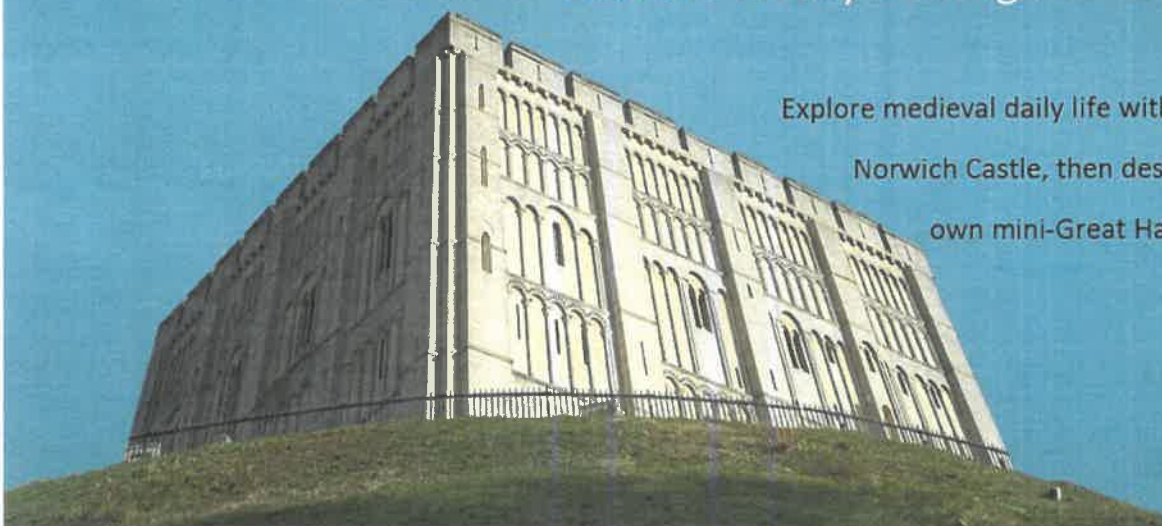
Get Ready for Battle! Friday 3 August 2018
