Dear Parents,

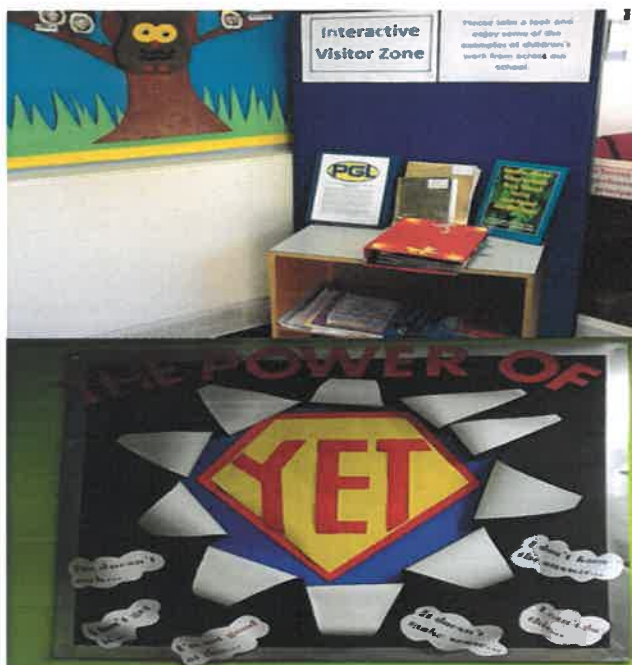
Welcome back!

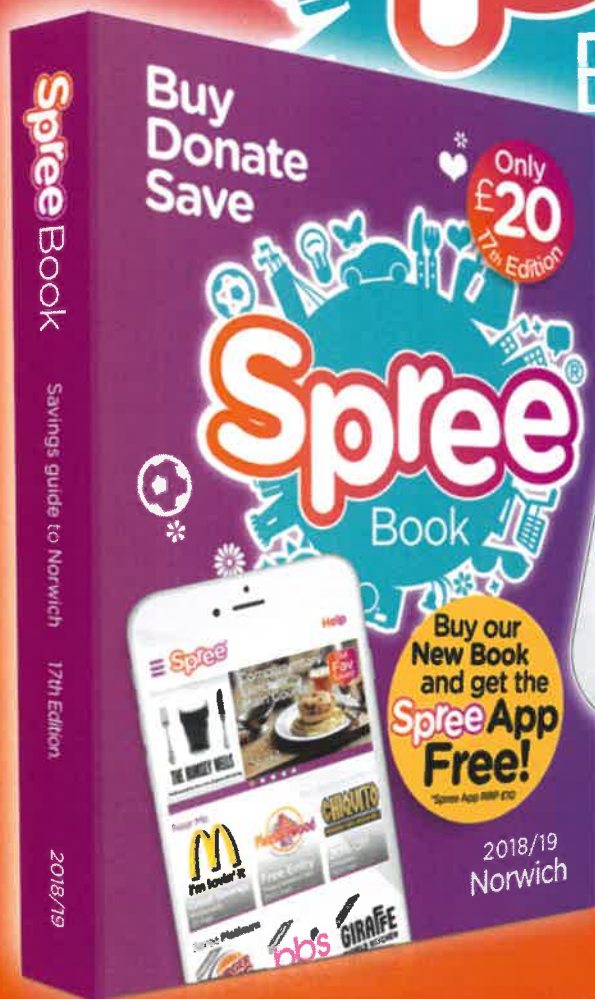
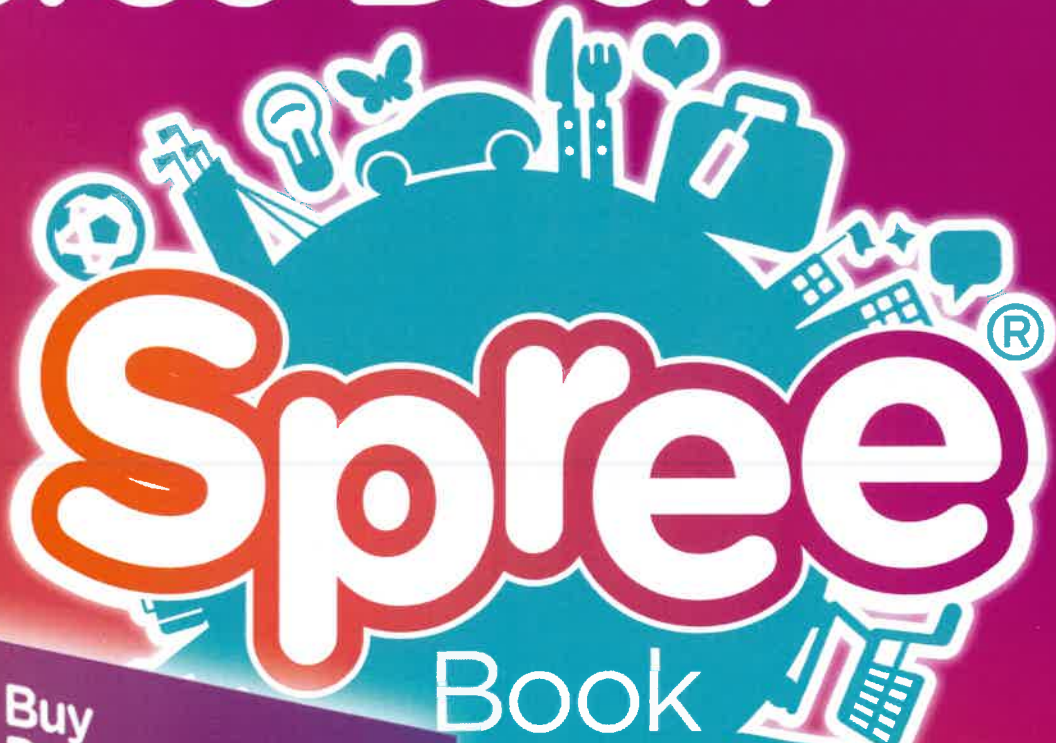
