Uniform Policy

1. To provide an affordable, practical and safe range of school wear.
2. To ensure pupils are correctly dressed in accordance with our Health & Safety policy.
3. To ensure pupils are smartly dressed, promoting the image of the school to the wider community.
4. To encourage a sense of community and belonging.

- *Navy blue or red sweatshirt or cardigan
- *Navy blue or red polo shirt
- *House coloured P.E. round-neck t-shirt
- *Navy P.E. shorts
- Navy, black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Royal or navy blue /white or red/white striped or checked dress (summer only) (optional)
- Navy, black or grey shorts (summer term only)
- White cotton shirt (summer term only)
- Plain tracksuit (for colder weather)
- Sensible plain shoes (not trainers)
- Plain black/navy socks
- Trainers for P.E.
- Plimsolls or bare feet for gym
- Wellingtons for playtimes
- Plain swimming trunks/costume
- Swimming cap

- All uniform to be clearly named.
- Jewellery, if worn, is strictly limited to one small pair of stud earrings and a watch. These must be removed for PE and swimming.
- Some indoor PE lessons require children to work barefoot for greater sensitivity.
- Hair should be of a moderate style and if long, should be tied back for Health & Safety reasons, hair accessories to be simple.
- No nail varnish or make up should be worn.
- PE uniform and equipment should be contained within a bag.
- Sunglasses if a medical reason.
- Sunhats are allowed.
- Cycle helmets are very strongly encouraged for all children cycling to school.
