



## Christmas 2018 At Little Melton Primary School

Ticket requests for the evening Play Performances of 'The Inn-spectors' are attached to this letter. Requests should be returned by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November in a named envelope via your child, using the **class basket system ONLY**. Tickets will be returned to you in the envelope via your child's book bag. There will be no benefit in delivering them personally to the school office!

To cover performance costs, we ask for a contribution of £1.00 per ticket. Tickets are limited to 2 per family in total due to the increasing pupil numbers and the space available in the hall. Please state on the request form if you would like to be considered for any 'spare' tickets we may have. We will maintain a list, and names will be drawn from a hat.

**Costumes** ~ your child will be given details of their costume for the Christmas play in due course. If you have any difficulties providing the costume, please speak to your class teacher. Please send costumes into school in a named plastic bag by **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> December** for dress rehearsals.

After dropping off your child/ren, parents should enter the school via the outside hall door so that tickets can be collected. Parents without tickets to that evening's performance are welcome to wait in the Barn Owls classroom.

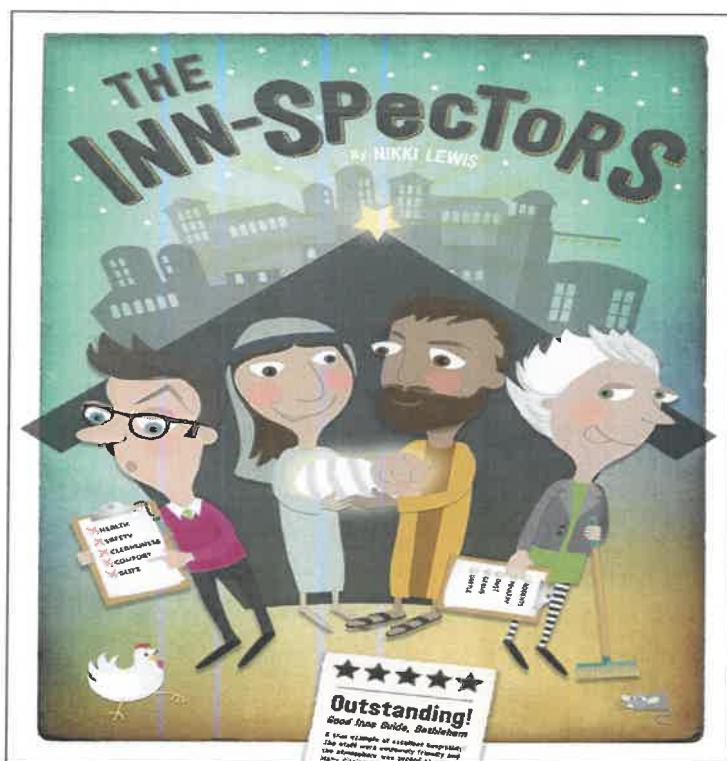
