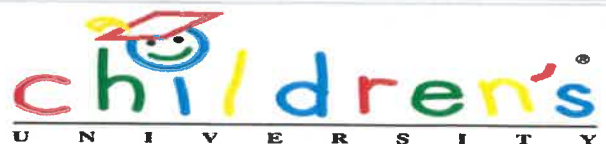
Today in school I have been conducting interviews with the children who have applied for different monitor jobs around the school. The successful applicants will be starting their roles in the next couple of weeks.
