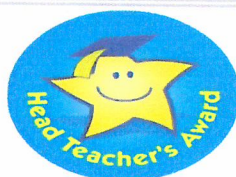
Finally, tomorrow is Red Nose Day for Comic Relief; the children are invited to come to school in non-uniform with a suggested donation of £1.

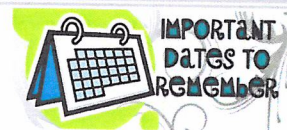

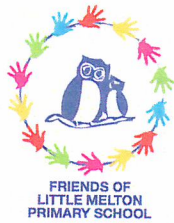
This year we are looking to fund new science and technology equipment.

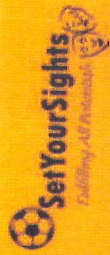
