Dear Parents,

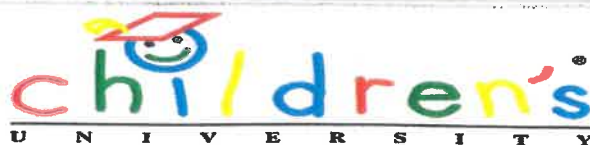
