Dear Parents,

Welcome back! I hope that you all had an excellent Easter holiday!

Already this term we have had three exciting achievements for children at the school.

First, a team of children from Year 5 and 6, led by Mrs Awbery and Mrs Graves, have had their entry chosen for the finals of the Belling Cooking Club school competition. Well done to George, Joshua, Millie, Evie and Jake. The children had to design an information poster for a recipe they had carried out at a school cookery club. The winning entry (with the most votes) receives £2,000 in school cookery equipment. Second, another team of Year 5 children, this time led by Mrs Bushell and Mrs Awbery, have been brilliantly successful at the F1 Jaguar Challenge event held at Sprowston Academy this week. This was a lengthy STEM project in which the children had to learn about racing cars and then design their own prototype. They also had to write letters to win sponsorship from companies, and present their display and ideas to a large audience. There were many other schools involved, some with prior experience, but despite this, our team came second overall and have made it to the national finals in Warwickshire in June! They also won the award for best 'pit display'. Well done to Daisy, Freya, Leena, Noah, and Toby!

Finally, on Thursday 25th April we took 6 of our Year 5 and 6 girls to the first of a 3 day tournament for Netball Development. For our first day we were very successful and won all of our matches. Well done to Alana, Edith, Lily, Ella, Daisy and Leena. The next round is Thursday 16th May at City Academy.

The Mayfair is coming ever closer. Thanks to everyone who contributed to the Teddy Tombola last week. I know that Friends are still looking for any more offers of help with stalls on the day- even if it's only for an hour or so. Please talk to Sarah Wilson if you are available to do this.

We are always keen to try to do more to highlight the importance to the children of recycling and looking after the environment. A new small step we would like to make is to attempt to improve the recycling of plastics from lunchtimes.

Children in Year 2 have recently completed a topic on recycling, and children in Eagle Owls have now written to the company that send us our packed lunches to try and reduce the amount of plastic coming in from them.

We are also hoping to improve our recycling further at lunchtimes by sending home packed lunch boxes with their containers. I hope that items such as yoghurt pots and drink containers can then be recycled appropriately – we do not have the resources to deal with this effectively in school. We are however, able to take all crisp packets and recycle them raising money for an animal sanctuary. The children are all very interested in the impact that they can have on the environment and we hope that you will support us in this small step.






