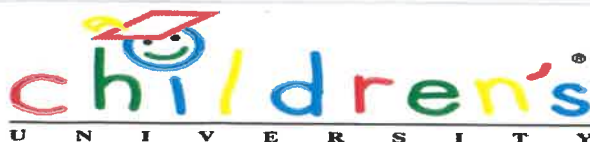
Tonight the Friends are holding their final preparatory meeting for the May Fair. It starts at 7.30pm and will be held in school. All welcome to attend.
