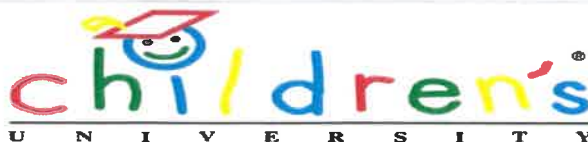

After School Clubs also count towards Children's University Credits.

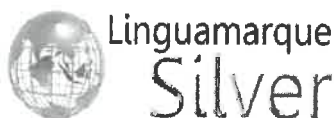
