Dear Parents

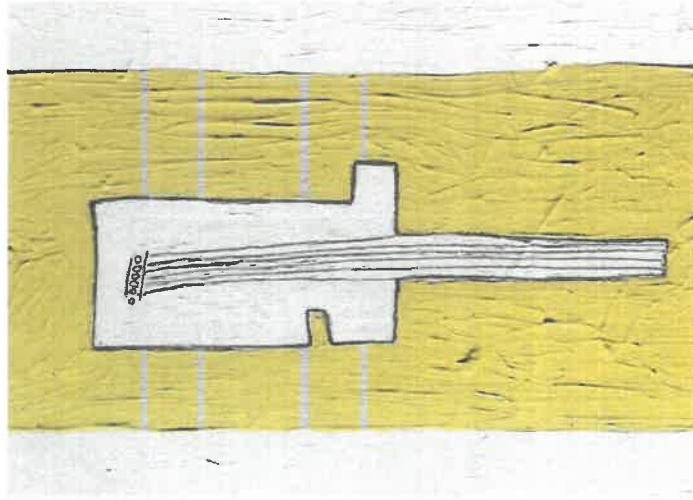

Come and find out what the mobile library offers. If your child has a library card, please bring it along. If you'd like to join the library for free it would speed up the process if you were able to complete the attached joining form. You can join the whole family on one form.

Did you know?

- You can borrow books, DVDs, puzzles and games from the mobile, and keep books for up to 8 weeks.
- Items borrowed from the mobile library can be returned to any branch library in Norfolk, and vice versa.
- On the Mobile Library there are no charges for overdue books
- You can order specific books to be delivered on the mobile library, and reservations are free for children.
- You can receive reminders by email letting you know that your books are due back before they are overdue
- e-books, e-audio books and e-magazines and can be downloaded free with a library membership, see www.norfolk.gov.uk/libraries for more information.
- We visit every 4 weeks and will next be visiting on: 2nd October, 30th October, 27th November, 22nd January - you can find more details about mobile library stops at www.norfolk.gov.uk/mobilelibraries or sign up to our free email reminders.

Data Protection Information

We need to maintain a record about our customers to be able to provide them with our services. This information is stored on the library system Spydus, through which you will be able to place reservations and keep a track of your loans. Both Norfolk County Council and Spydus will adhere to the strictest protection and confidence when handling your personal data.

We record: your name, address, phone number, e-mail address, date of birth, whether you are registered disabled, have a sight disability or whether you are housebound, as well as your ethnic background. A record of your use of library services, any money you owe Norfolk Library & Information Service for borrowing or requesting items and any comments and suggestions you make about the service will also be recorded.

The information held, will be used for administration of library services: notifications, statistics, monitoring and development of library services. If you chose to be part of our mailing list, your information may be used to keep you informed of new library services or other Norfolk County Council business.

Norfolk County Council is registered under the General Data Protection Regulations 2018. Some information is collected as part of the requirements of the Race Relations Amendment Act (2000). All information is kept secure, whether on paper or on a computer.

If you ticked the box to receive the mobile library reminder email then we will record your name and address, alongside your route numbers, within our mailing list. You can withdraw consent whenever. We will not share your information with anyone else and will only contact you for the reminder emails and in the case of a route being cancelled unexpectedly.

Your personal information will be kept no longer than is necessary for the purpose stated. Your information will not be shared with anyone else without your permission.

You can ask to see the information held about you and ask for any wrong details to be put right. If you wish to see your records, please contact Norfolk Library & Information Service on 01603 222580.
