Lower Key Stage 2 French: Year 3/4 (Cycle A)

Topic: Classroom Instructions
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for basic classroom instructions, greetings, introduction to France

Topic: Name, Age
Key Themes: Saying what our name is and asking another, saying our age, numbers 1-20

Topic: Days of the week, Months, Birthdays
Key Themes: Learning the days and months, numbers 20-31, saying when our birthday is, writing a party invitation

Topic: Body Parts
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for various body parts, describing aliens body parts, basic sentence structures

Topic: Describing somebody
Key Themes: Key words and phrases to describe hair and eyes, height, personality traits, describing a friend orally and in writing

Lower Key Stage 2 French: Year 3/4 (Cycle B)

Topic: Greetings
Key Themes: Saying hello/goodbye, asking how you are, asking what your name and age is, basic conversational role play

Topic: Numbers 1-20, Colours
Key Themes: Recognising numbers 1-20, key vocab for colours, saying what their favourite colour is, Christmas in France

Topic: Family
Key Themes: Learning the days and months, numbers 20-31, saying when our birthday is, writing a party invitation

Topic: Food
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for popular foods, talking about their likes and dislikes, exploring traditional French foods

Topic: Places in town
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for landmarks in a town, writing about a fictional town, exploring French towns

Upper Key Stage 2 French: Year 5/6 (Cycle A)

Topic: Numbers to 100, Classroom Objects
Key Themes: Recognising numbers 1-100, key words and phrases for classroom objects, describing position of objects using prepositions

Topic: Weather
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for describing the weather, preparing an oral weather report for France

Topic: Time
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for o'clock, half past, quarter past and to; reading analogue and digital times

Topic: School Subjects
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for school subjects, giving opinions of subjects and justifying opinions, comparing school day to our partner school

Topic: Daily Routine
Key Themes: Key words and phrases to describe morning and evening routine, preparing a short written presentation about their routine using time phrases

Upper Key Stage 2 French: Year 5/6 (Cycle B)

Topic: Classroom Commands / Francophone countries
Key Themes: Saying and responding to basic classroom commands, learning about different cultures in Francophone countries and identifying these on a map

Topic: Sports
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for sports and pastimes, preparing a short presentation about their opinions of sports, exploring French sporting events and famous athletes

Topic: My hometown
Key Themes: Describing our own village/local area, giving directions, comparing our local area to our partner school

Topic: French Café
Key Themes: Role play conversational French as waiters at a café, learning about different French foods and drinks, preparing a French café experience

Topic: My house
Key Themes: Key words and phrases for rooms in a house, describing our own house, comparing our houses to houses in Francophone countries

Key subject specific vocabulary

General vocabulary for language learning: cognate, accent, pronunciation, masculine, feminine, plural
