Complete metamorphosis: Insect life cycle which contains four stages (see below). Incomplete metamorphosis: Insect lifecycle with 3 stages (egg, nymph, and adult).

Placental mammals: A group of mammals who carry their young inside the mothers body until a late stage of development.

Marsupial mammals: A group of mammals whose young are born incompletely developed and are carried and suckled in a pouch on the mother's belly.

Monotreme mammals: A ancient group of mammals which lay eggs.


Lifecycle: Changes a living organism goes through.

required to produce new life.


Fertilization: Process of male and female sex cells fusing together.
