Earlier this week, the Department for Education released some specific guidance about holding sports days during the current phase of Coronavirus restrictions.

The good news at least, is that they can go ahead this year, with spectators, but with restrictions in place.

With this in mind, and to give as much notice as possible, the dates for our Sports Day this year will be:

Tuesday July 13th 1.30pm (weather permitting)

Reserve Day: Tuesday July 20th 1.30pm.

There are a number of restrictions that we will however have to follow in order to host this event. They are primarily around reducing the number of close contacts for all visitors to the site and maintaining the bubble arrangements for the children. We will share the full final details of these rules nearer the time, just in case there are any changes to them enforced on us over the next few weeks.

We would also like this year to hold a version of our traditional Year 6 Leavers Assembly, with parents invited, as this is clearly an important life milestone for the children. Again, we are allowed to run an event like this, but within national restrictions. With this in mind, this year the event will only be able to be attended by families of the Year 6 children.

The event will be held outdoors on the school field with a contingency plan for using the school hall **with more tightly restricted numbers**, in the event of bad weather. We will share full final details of these rules nearer the time, just in case there are any changes to them enforced on us over the next few weeks.

As an aside, we have decided to trial holding the event in the morning this year, because some of the children in past years have become quite emotional, and we wondered if this way they would be more able to enjoy the rest of their last day in school saying a more considered goodbye to friends and school staff.
