Yesterday we welcomed Suzy from Norwich School Sports Partnership for our 'Day of Calm'. All of the children took part in activities designed to help children recognise and manage their emotions using physical activity.

On Tuesday, children in Key Stage 2 enjoyed a fascinating assembly from Phil Royle (Grace's Dad) all about website design. This was to fit in with work in our Upper Key Stage 2 Computing curriculum. Year 5 are currently building their own websites on Google Sites, and Phil's input will help them to further refine their ideas.

Last Friday the children in Key Stage 2 took part in a 'Fantastic Forces' afternoon with Dr Lucy Cato. They learnt about some of the science behind paper aeroplanes, and greatly enjoyed testing out the models that they had made. 
