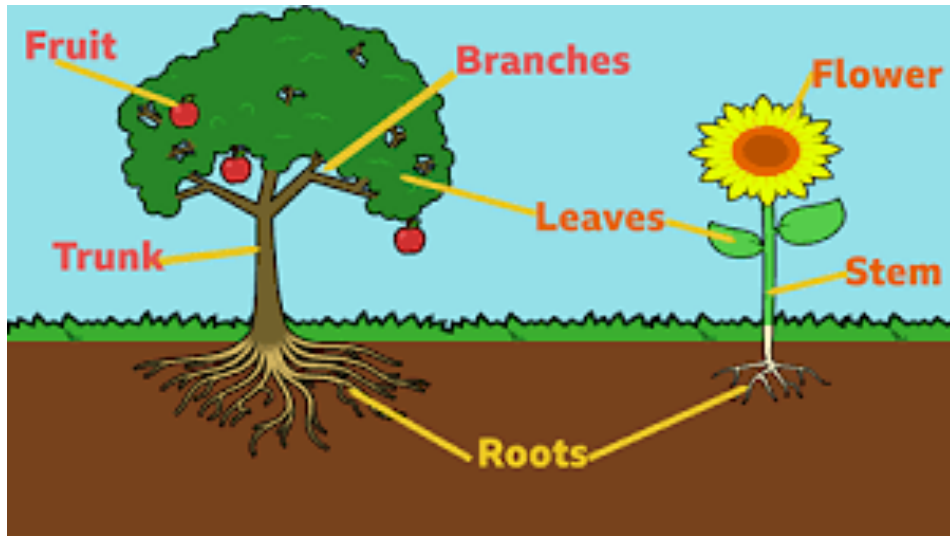


Science - Parts of a plant and tree

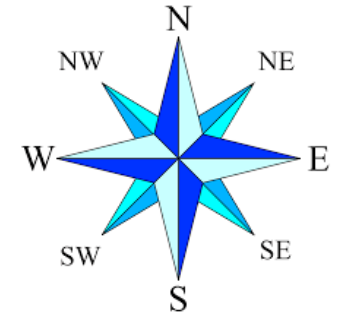


- **Roots** hold the plant in place. They also suck up water.
- The **stem** carries nutrients (food) to the parts of the plant and keeps the plant upright.
- **Leaves** are flat and collect sunlight to turn into food.
- **Petals** attract bees using different scent, colour and size.

Plants need **light**, water, suitable **temperature** and **air** to grow.

Geography - The UK

A **compass** helps us describe directions e.g. North, South, East and West.
